Learning Outcomes <u>Top</u>

This module is an elective for students doing a business minor. It equips future business managers with an awareness of the legal implications of commercial transactions and the importance of conducting business within the law. In the course of the module, you will gain exposure to legal reasoning, application, analysis, synthesis and critical evaluation. The Law pervades everyday commercial life. This module introduces you to the legal environment and the common legal issues confronting businesses. In transacting business, disputes invariably arise and it is essential to know the avenues for dispute resolution in the most expedient and cost-effective manner. It is also essential to understand the impact of certain areas of the law on business and these include

commercial contracts, business organisations, corporate management and e Commerce. Case studies will be used to reflect real world issues and for learning legal and commercial lessons.

 Introduction to the legal environment including the impact of current legal developments on business activities

- Dispute resolution including mediation and arbitration
- Forms of business organisations and corporate management responsibilities
- Commercial contracts including sale of goods provisions
- E commerce law including cyber contracts, online defamation, jurisdictional issues, hyperlinking, cybersquatting and protection of domain names
