



## **Dr GAO Jian**

**Senior Economist, founder of China's debt capital market**

Dr Gao Jian graduated with a Doctorate in Finance from the Institute of Financial Sciences of the Ministry of Finance and completed post-doctoral studies in the Department of Economics at Harvard University in 1998.

Dr Gao started his career at the Ministry of Finance, where he held several important positions between 1989 and 1998. He was the first Deputy Direct General of the Department of Laws and Regulations and Vice Direct General of the Department of State Debt Administration, the Direct General of the Department of State Debt Administration in 1994, and the Direct General of the Department of Laws and Regulations in 1998.

Dr Gao then moved to China Development Bank (CDB) in late 1998, where he held the positions of Chief Economist and Direct General of the Treasury Department of CDB in October 1998, and Assistant Governor of CDB in April 2001. He was the Vice Governor of CDB at Vice-Ministerial level in July 2003 and was appointed as the Vice Governor, Executive Member of the Board of CDB Corporation, and Chairman of CDB Securities in December 2008. He was also the Chairman of Sino African Fund and Vice Chairman of Mandarin Capital between 2006 and 2008. He has been the Senior Advisor of CDB and Chairman of CDB Securities since September 2012.

Dr Gao was a visiting scholar in the Department of Economics of Harvard University in 2013 and 2014, and he was also a visiting scholar in the Institute of Management Science at Bologna University from May to July in 2015. Dr Gao is currently a distinguished visiting fellow at the National University of Singapore Business School Asia Accounting Research Centre & China Business Centre.
