MINOR IN REAL ESTATE PROGRAMME

The requirement for the Minor Programme in Real Estate is 20 units. To satisfy this requirement, students must read outside their major, the following courses offered by the Department of Real Estate. All courses are worth 4 units.

Students will read 2 compulsory foundation courses – RE1701 Urban Land Use & Development and RE1705 Real Estate Finance and Accounting or ACC1701/ACC1701X Accounting for Decision Makers. The remaining 12 units can be a combination of courses from Level 1000 to Level 3000. These are listed in Table 1.

In addition, students can only read a maximum of 12 units of Level 1000 courses (including the compulsory courses).
