5th year support is generally provided but the extent of which is based on student's satisfactory progress in the programme.

- Teaching Opportunities: Students who have defended their thesis proposal may become part-time tutors to develop their pedagogical skills.
- Post-Qualifying Examination Top-Up: PhD scholars may receive an extra stipend after passing the PhD Qualifying Examination (QE).
